
# CALL FOR: ARTISTS, FILMMAKERS, MUSICIANS and the PUBLIC

**51zero/festival is back this year from 25th October to 17th November in Rochester and Canterbury**. Imagining the two towns as 'galleries', public venues and outdoor spaces as interlinked 'exhibition rooms', the festival aims to be accessible to everyone.

The festival's programme will showcase artists and practitioners that are among the best and most representative working in film and contemporary art alongside new talent, presenting local, national and international visual artists and filmmakers whose production is between contemporary art and cinema. Together, with moving image, the festival also presents live music, performance, sculpture, talks and participatory projects.

One of this year's themes is the idea of rebirth, renewal and starting again. Resident artist David Goldenberg will introduce *Granulation*, a collective public installation, encouraging contributions to a collaborative artwork and a discussion on art in response to the festival program. Goldenberg aims to use exhibited artworks and festival activities to construct formal ideas of how art takes place today, exploring how these ideas could be unfixed and reconstituted to develop new languages of art, in particular, a new language of art for Medway.

We invite contributions from artists, filmmakers, musicians and the general public; submitted work will become an integral part of 51zero festival 2019 and inform the *Granulation* project.

# **Call 1 - Artists and Filmmakers**

We are looking for artists and filmmakers to submit work in the following formats - film, digital work, sculpture, performance (or other proposed formats), to be exhibited in both Rochester and Canterbury.

- You can submit new or existing work.
- For films longer than 20 minutes and installations we might need you to supply your own equipment.
- We welcome different concepts, subjects and styles. However your work must be suitable for our venues. No violence or explicit content.

# Call 2 - Musicians, composers, sound artists and singers

To launch the festival, we are planning a night of screenings accompanied by live music, live sound and voice. We are looking for musicians and singers to perform original pieces or existing scores to accompany moving image (links to short films will be provided), at Rochester Cathedral crypt, Kent, ME1 1SX, on Friday October 25th 2019.

- You could create a new composition or perform existing music, samples or remixes.
- It could be instrumental or vocal, solo or ensemble and of different genres (classical, experimental, jazz, funk, baroque, electronic, etc.), however you creatively respond to the film.
- Please consider the acoustics of the venue (crypt of Rochester Cathedral).
- Please note that the sourcing of equipment and musicians are your responsibility, however, some support may be available.

# Call 3 – Work experience/Volunteers – Open to All

We are currently offering placements to work with 51zero team and engage with the creative production, curation and exhibition of 51zero festival events 2019, from July to October/November with a possible extension into 2020, which may translate into paid positions. Time is flexible and open to negotiation. This opportunity is open to those interested in gaining work experience in the arts, receiving mentoring as well as having a space to test ideas and the chance to present work, exhibiting in a professional environment outside the university. The October festival events will occupy a number of venues each requiring a different curatorial approach and present a programme of work responding to different strands, suitable for the type of audiences the venues attracts.

- You will collaborate with practitioners on aspects of curation and exhibition, as well as production, management and delivery of events.
- You are invited to submit work to the programme (see open calls above)
- You can work part time or full time from the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of July up to November at the Festival venues and at 51zero office in Rochester historic centre, 5 min walk from the train station; subsistence will be provided.

# Call 4 – Granulation – Open to All

As part of 51zero festival, UK-based artist David Goldenberg is coordinating a new collective public installation entitled *Granulation*, situated in Rochester High Street.

"How can we use art works and other activities as molecules to build an overview of how art takes place today, then take those molecules and rebuild the body of art differently?"

"If it is possible to start again, how do we start a new language for art and what form should it or can it take? To develop a new language of art for Medway, people should have an active role in shaping this language, where we are all starting from the same position".

The project belongs to the people of Rochester whose input and contribution are key for the installation to be realised. People are invited to contribute ideas, material and objects, take part in discussions and make work during the first week of the festival, collaborating with the artist in creating the installation.

#### - Participating in the Installation

Contributing ideas, material and objects should respond to the concept of rebirth and renewal, "starting a new language of art for Medway". These can take any form, such as digital/online material (e.g. text,

images, text/image, essay, etc.), found objects from the public realm or personal items that tell a story about art in the area (e.g books, photographs, clothing, art, poetry, letters, etc), or people. Unless agreed, objects should be small scale and portable.

# - Participating in the talk and discussion (Sat 2<sup>nd</sup> November - NB venue may change)

The aim is to develop a discussion from material that is sent to the festival. The collective material will be used to provide an informed insight into how art works today, framing a context to pose a further question: how does art function in Medway and what language is specific to discussing this art?

Key questions as introduction to talks and discussions include: What resources, material and information do we need to stage an event that facilitates this process? Why do we want to do this? How will we do this? What are the expectations? What form should a new work (art installation) take in building a new language of art?
